

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR A NON-ENDOWED FUND

NAME OF NON-ENDOWED FUND

EntourAGE Scholarship

PURPOSE OF FUND

Financially support students who are conducting research at the University of Ottawa LIFE Research Institute on the quality of life of older adults.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
2. be registered as a full-time or part-time student in a graduate program with a thesis requirement or a doctoral program at the University of Ottawa; and
3. be conducting research as part of their program on the quality of life of older adults and be supervised by a principal or affiliated member of the LIFE Research Institute, at the University of Ottawa.

Note: All else being equal, the applicant must demonstrate academic excellence.

Note 2: No recipient of this scholarship can receive it more than twice.

Value of the award: \$5,000

Number of awards: Two (One for a PhD student, one for a student in another graduate program with a thesis requirement)

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Graduate

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through the uoZone portal, and should include:

1. the Curriculum Vitae on Online Scholarships and Bursaries;
2. the questionnaire in which the applicant must provide the following information:
 - a. details on the applicant's publications (max. 1 page)
 - b. the applicant's research focus (max. 1 page)
 - c. a detailed summary of the relevance of the applicant's research to the quality of life of older adults (max. 1 page)
3. two letters of recommendation, including one from the applicant's supervisor.
