### **NAME OF ENDOWMENT FUND**

#### **Roger Guindon Scholarship Fund**

### **INTRODUCTION**

The University of Ottawa named this scholarship fund in honour of Reverend Father Roger Guindon, o.m.i. The Reverend Father Guindon spent number of years at the University of Ottawa, first as a student from 1933 to 1947. He then taught theology during 17 years. In 1959, the Reverend Father was promoted Dean of Theology, position he filled until he was named Rector of the University of Ottawa in 1964. His mandate ended in 1984, at the time of his retirement.

### **PURPOSE OF FUND**

Provide financial support in recognition of the good academic standing of students registered at the University of Ottawa and who are involved in one or more activities on campus or in their community.

### **SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS**

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

The applicant must:

1. be registered at the University of Ottawa;
2. have completed at least twelve (12) credits;
3. in the case of undergraduate students, have a minimum CGPA of 8.0; and
4. be involved in one or more extracurricular activities, either at the university, in the community, in sports, in arts or other.
