

## TERMS OF REFERENCE

### Name of Endowed Fund

# Dr. Sidney Medine Essex County Medical Student Scholarship

## PURPOSE OF FUND

To award scholarships to students from Essex County pursuing medical studies at a school in Ontario. For the purposes of the scholarship, Essex County includes the following southwestern Ontario municipalities: Windsor, Tecumseh, Lasalle, Lakeshore, Amherstburg, Essex, Kingsville and Leamington.

## SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

### Eligibility criteria

Applicants must:

- Be a Canadian citizen.
- Be enrolled as a full-time student or as a resident in a program at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ottawa.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Demonstrate academic excellence.
- Intend to establish a medical practice in Essex County for a minimum of two years after graduation.

**Award value:** Maximum \$13,000

**Number of awards:** Maximum of three

**Award frequency:** Annual

**Level or program of study:** Undergraduate or postgraduate

**Application contact:** Financial Aid and Awards Service

**Application deadline:** April 30

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through uoZone. They should include the following:

1. the Financial Questionnaire
2. proof of permanent residency in Essex County (e.g., a copy of a driver's licence)
3. proof of Canadian citizenship (e.g., a copy of a passport)
4. a letter from the Faculty of Medicine confirming the applicant's enrolment, including the applicant's current year of study and confirmation of their satisfactory academic standing
5. a letter from the applicant detailing their intent to establish a medical practice in Essex County for a minimum of two years following the completion of medical education, including residencies.

**Note:** Nominations will be sent to the Estate of Dr. S. Medine — Essex County Medical Student Scholarship Fund. The estate will select the recipients and award the scholarship directly to them.
