# INTERNATIONAL ENGLISH ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

#### INTRODUCTION

The University of Ottawa is proud of its internationally diverse student body. As a result, international students from these countries will benefit from significant reductions in their tuition fees when they study in one of the eligible undergraduate programs offered in English.

#### PURPOSE OF FUND

The objective of this fund is to provide financial assistance to newly admitted anglophone international students who began their first term of studies as of Fall 2024 (Faculty of Arts as of Fall 2025). This scholarship is for students from Africa, India, Bangladesh, Indonesia or Vietnam and registered in an approved specific undergraduate program at the University of Ottawa.

#### **SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS**

## **Eligibility Criteria**

The applicant must:

- have a valid study permit;
- 2. be a citizen of any country in Africa, India, Bangladesh, Indonesia or Vietnam;
- 3. be newly admitted in the Fall term of 2024 or later (Faculty of Arts as of Fall 2025 or later) in one of the eligible undergraduate programs in English in one of the faculties listed;
- 4. not enrol in the French immersion stream; and
- 5 be enrolled full-time

### **Renewal Criteria**

This scholarship can be renewed for up to a maximum of 12 installments if the student meets these renewal criteria:

- 1. Maintain full-time enrolment in the undergraduate program in which the student was admitted and enrolled;
- 2. Have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 5.0 or higher at the end of each academic year.

## **Spring-Summer Criteria**

Students enrolled full-time in the Spring-Summer term will receive their full scholarship installment, conditional on meeting all renewal criteria.

This scholarship can also be renewed at 50% of its original value during part-time Spring-Summer terms if the student registers part-time during the Spring-Summer term to at least 6 units (2 courses).

A 50% part-time renewal will count as a full installment towards the total of 12 possible installments.

Students wishing to receive an installment in the Spring-Summer term will be required to submit an application through Online Scholarships and Bursaries portal in uoZone.

### Notes

- 1. This scholarship cannot be combined with the International English Excellence Scholarship;
- 2. This scholarship cannot be combined with Differential Tuition Fee Exemption Scholarship for international students studying in French;
- 3. This scholarship is not awarded during CO-OP work term;
- 4. Temporary interruption of studies, or part-time registration, or as a non-degree student will terminate the scholarship for the remaining of the studies.
- 5. Students from Africa, India, Bangladesh, Indonesia or Vietnam are eligible.
