# Nitrex DTI PhD Scholarship

## INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was generously created by Nitrex.

## PURPOSE OF FUND

To support a third or fourth year PhD student in the Digital Transformation and Innovation (DTI) program of the Telfer School of Management at the University of Ottawa who has successfully defended their PhD proposal.

## SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

### Eligibility criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected or refugee status, or an international student.
- Be enrolled as a full-time third or fourth year doctoral student in DTI program of the University of Ottawa supervised by a Telfer School of Management professor.
- Have successfully defended their PhD proposal.
- Demonstrate the potential impact of their research.

**Award value:** \$4,500

**Number of awards:** 2

**Award frequency:** Annual

**Level or program of study:** Doctoral

**Application contact:** Financial Aid and Awards Service

**Application deadline:** October 31

**Note:** Preference will be given to applicants who have not received a Telfer DTI admission scholarship or other internal Telfer funding during the DTI program.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through uoZone. They should include the following:

- confirmation that the applicant has successfully defended their PhD proposal (e.g., a copy of their transcripts indicating a “Satisfactory” grade for the PhD proposal)
- a letter (max. 500 words) demonstrating the potential impact of their thesis research
