NAME OF NON-ENDOWED FUND (OTSS)

Huguette Labelle Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was created in partnership with the Fondation franco-ontarienne in honour of Huguette Labelle, chancellor of the University of Ottawa from 1994 to 2012.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To award a scholarship to a student enrolled in a French-language program at the University of Ottawa, whether undergraduate or graduate.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with protected or refugee status;
2. Be enrolled full time in a French-language undergraduate or graduate program at the University of Ottawa;
3. Be an Ontario resident as per OSAP (Ontario Student Assistance Program) regulations; and
4. Demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.

Value of award:	A minimum of \$1,000 and a maximum of \$5,000
Number of awards:	Variable
Frequency of the award:	Annual
Level or program of study:	Undergraduate or graduate
Application contact:	Financial Aid and Awards Service
Application deadline:	October 31
