NAME OF ENDOWED FUND

Tito Scaiano Scholarship for International Students

INTRODUCTION

This fund was established in 2004 by Dr. Tito Scaiano, a Professor of Chemistry since 1991 at the University of Ottawa's Faculty of Science. In 2000, he was awarded the Distinguished Professor Award by the University, the first professor appointed to this rank.

Dr. Scaiano wishes to thank and acknowledge the following contributors to this fund:

- Distinguished Professor Award; and
- the many private donations for doubling the fund's capital.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To financially support graduate students registered at the Department of Chemistry and Biomolecular Sciences.

DETAILS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be an international student;
2. be admitted or registered for five years or less as a full-time student in a graduate program at the Department of Chemistry and Biomolecular Sciences of the University of Ottawa; and
3. demonstrate academic excellence.

Value of the award: Minimum \$8,000

*For students who are not recipients of the differential tuition scholarship, the amount should be equivalent to the difference between the tuition fees for Canadian students and the tuition fees for international students.

*If the student is a recipient of the differential tuition scholarship, the amount awarded will be considered as a separate, further financial supplement.

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Renewable: Yes, for one additional year, provided the recipient is in good academic standing and submits a letter of support from their supervisor.

Level or program of study: Graduate

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through the uoZone portal, and should include:

1. an unofficial copy of the applicant's transcript;
