NAME OF ENDOWED FUND

Keith Fagnou Memorial Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was created in honour of Keith Fagnou, esteemed professor of chemistry at the Faculty of Science. With the faculty since 2002, Professor Fagnou was awarded a University of Ottawa Research Chair in the Development of Novel Catalytic Transformations in 2007. An outstanding researcher, he won several prestigious awards, including the Polanyi prize in 2003.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To recognize a deserving student registered in a graduate program at the Department of Chemistry at the Faculty of Science of the University of Ottawa.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
2. be registered as a full-time student in a Master's or Ph.D. program at Department of Chemistry at the Faculty of Science; and
3. demonstrate motivation, determination and diligence in the pursuit of his/her academic goals and future career, as well as in other aspects of his/her life.

Note : Preference will be given to students who have not previously received an award or scholarship since the start of his/her graduate program.

Value of the award: Minimum \$5,000

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Master's and Doctorate

Application deadline: October 31

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries and should include:

1. the Curriculum Vitae on Online Scholarships and Bursaries;
2. an unofficial copy of the applicant's transcript;
3. a letter (500 words) describing your motivation, and diligence in the pursuit of his/her academic goals and future career, as well as in other aspects of his/her life; and
