

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR A FUND

Eastern Ontario Perseverance Scholarship

PURPOSE OF FUND

Rather than focus on academic excellence, this scholarship is to recognize the perseverance, commitment and success of students. It aims to facilitate the transition between high school and university education and encourage the pursuit of University studies in French.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person of protected/refugee status;
2. meet the admission requirements of the faculty concerned (Arts, Engineering, Health Sciences, Science, Social Sciences, Telfer School of Management or the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section);
3. be registered full time, and for the first time, in an undergraduate program and have a minimum of 12 credits in French per session;
4. Claim the scholarship within 3 years from the date of the nomination;
5. Not be registered to another university before your admission at the University of Ottawa;
6. Come from a high school from one of the following school boards:
 - a) CÉP de l'Est de l'Ontario;
 - b) CSDC du Centre-Est de l'Ontario;
 - c) CSDC de l'Est ontarien

Note: The recipients of this award will be nominated by the academic counsellors of the schools in question.

Value of the award: \$1,000

Number of awards: One for a student from every high school in the three school boards mentioned above

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate
