

TERMS OF REFERENCE

UNIVERSITY OF OTTAWA ADMISSION SCHOLARSHIP

INTRODUCTION

The Admission Scholarship is offered to newly admitted students who are undertaking university studies for the first time. Scholarship offers are based on admission average criteria, which vary according to the program you are admitted to. Offers are not transferable to another program.

Note: This Admission Scholarship is offered to newly admitted students who began their first year of studies as of Winter 2023 or later.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- 1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or have protected person or refugee status;
- 2. be registered full time in a direct-entry faculty or in the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section;
- 3. fulfill the admission requirements of the faculty in question (Arts, Engineering, Health Sciences, Science, Social Sciences, Telfer School of Management or the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section);
- 4. have an admission average between 85% and 100%.

The amount varies from \$1,000 to \$3,000 according to the grid below:

- a. 95-100% - \$3,000
- b. 90-94.9% - \$2,000
- c. 85-89.9% - \$1,000

NOTE: Mature applicants and university transfers are not eligible for this scholarship.
