

## **TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AN ENDOWMENT FUND**

### **TITLE OF ENDOWMENT FUND**

#### **Accenture Scholarship Fund**

### **PURPOSE OF FUND**

The purpose of the fund is to award an annual scholarship to a student in their 4<sup>th</sup> year of study at the Telfer School of Management or in the Computer Science Program at the Faculty of Engineering.

### **SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS**

#### **Eligibility Criteria**

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
2. have successfully completed their third year of studies and be registered in the fourth year of a program at the Telfer School of Management or the Computer Science Program at the Faculty of Engineering;
3. demonstrate leadership in extracurricular activities, such as professional/school/social/community organizations, sports or part-time employment;
4. demonstrate academic excellence (students from the Telfer School of Management with a CGPA of at least 7.5, and students from the Faculty of Engineering with a CGPA of at least 8.0.); and
5. demonstrate an interest in pursuing a career in consulting.

**Value of the award:** Minimum \$1,000

**Number of awards:** One (alternating between the Telfer School of Management and the Computer Science Program)

**Frequency of the award:** Annual

**Level or program of study:** Undergraduate

### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**
