Lise Desmarais Bursary for Language Teaching

INTRODUCTION

This bursary was generously created by Lise Desmarais.

After studying translation, Lise Desmarais made the shift to language teaching and worked in this area her entire career. Starting as a French teacher for federal public servants, she became, in turn, an academic adviser, training officer, educational material developer and, lastly, a specialist in language teaching. She studied linguistics and educational technology, later receiving a doctorate in education with a specialization in language teaching. She has various publications to her credit, as well as having participated in symposiums and research groups in the field of language teaching.

In 2002, she received the Queen Elizabeth II Golden Jubilee Medal for her outstanding contributions to the Canadian Foreign Service Institute as a specialist in language teaching.
