# Derek Ricci Mobility Scholarship

## INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was generously created by Derek Ricci (BCom '02), a Toronto-based commercial litigator and partner at Davies Ward Phillips & Vineberg LLP. Derek, who received the Telfer Young Achiever's Award in 2019, is a dedicated mentor with the Telfer Executive Mentorship Program and fondly counts himself among the late professor Peter Koppel's TAs.

## PURPOSE OF FUND

To support students at the Telfer School of Management completing a co-op placement or internship in one of the three major metropolitan areas of Canada (Toronto, Vancouver or Montreal).

## SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

### Eligibility criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected or refugee status, or an international student.
2. Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in the Telfer School of Management of the University of Ottawa.
3. Be completing their co-op placement or internship in one of the following cities: Toronto, Montreal or Vancouver.

**Award value:** \$2,500

**Number of awards:** One

**Award frequency:** Annual

**Level or program of study:** Undergraduate

**Application deadline:** November 30, March 31, August 1 (only one award per academic year)

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through uoZone. They should include the following:

1. proof of their co-op or internship placement, including address of the employer
2. a detailed projected budget for the duration of the co-op placement including rent or lodging, food, travel and miscellaneous costs (with explanation)
