TITLE OF ENDOWED FUND

J. Léopold Vachon Fund

PURPOSE OF FUND

Provide financial aid to women students with Canadian citizenship or permanent residency status enrolled in a Frenchlanguage Honours Bachelor program at the Department of Mathematics and Statistics of the Faculty of Science, whose studies would otherwise be compromised.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- 1. be a woman who is a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident;
- 2. be registered as a full-time student in a French-language Honours Bachelor program at the Department of Mathematics and Statistics of the Faculty of Science;
- 3. meet the Ontario residency requirement, as per OSAP rules;
- 4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
- 5. have a minimum GPA of 4.5 in her mathematics courses at the University of Ottawa.

Note: Preference will be given to a student registered in a French-language Bachelor program with a major in mathematics.
