INTRODUCTION

This fund was established by Jacqueline Bossé-Andrieu in 1998, then vice-dean of the Faculty of Arts, and Geneviève Mareschal, then director of the School of Translation and Interpretation.

The donors thank the Alumni Association and the Government of Ontario for their contributions to this fund through their matching program.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To support students enrolled in the Faculty of Arts who wish to specialize in French.

AWARD DETAILS

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with protected or refugee status
- Be enrolled full time in second or third year of the honours bachelor's in *lettres françaises* or the major in French as a second language at the University of Ottawa.
- Meet the Ontario residency requirement, as per OSAP¹ rules.
- Demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.
- Have achieved a 7.5 average in the FRA or FLS courses in their chosen program.

Award value: Minimum \$1,000

Number of awards: Variable

Award frequency: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate

Application deadline: October 31
