SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria:

The applicant must:

1. be registered on a full-time basis in the first year of a Bachelor of Music program (including the BMus combined programs) in the School of Music of the University of Ottawa.
2. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules; and
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.
