Timothy W.R. Finkle Memorial Scholarship Fund

INTRODUCTION

This fund was established in memory of Timothy Finkle by family and friends. Tim grew up happily in Mississauga with his parents and four siblings. The love of his family and friends was first and foremost in his life. He attended Michael Power High School in Toronto where he participated in a student exchange in Germany. There, he discovered his love of languages and other cultures. After graduation from high school, Tim pursued his dream of bilingualism and attended the University of Ottawa, graduating with his BSc in 1986. Tim stayed in Ottawa; with his career, he was able to travel the world and became fluent in not only French, but also German, Spanish and Italian. At the time of Tim's passing in 1999, he was Vice President of the National Dairy Council of Canada and was engaged to be married. He was also enrolled in the Executive MBA program at the University of Ottawa. He will be remembered as a good listener and a great friend with a warm smile for everyone. PURPOSE OF FUND

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be registered as a full-time student in the second year of an undergraduate program at the Faculty of Science of the University of Ottawa;
2. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules;
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
4. have a minimum CGPA of 7.0.

Value of the award: Minimum \$3,500

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate
