Allison-Doucet Family Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was created in memory of Joseph Doucet (1903–1999), grandfather of Telfer graduate Alain Doucet (BCom '83). PURPOSE OF FUND

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants must:

- 1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with protected/refugee status;
- 2. be enrolled full-time at the Telfer School of Management;
- 3. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules:
- 4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa;
- 5. participate in an academic exchange or internship abroad; and
- 6. be in good academic standing.

Value of the award: Minimum \$1,000

Number of awards: One Frequency of the award: Annual

Level of the award: Undergraduate

APPLICATION PROCEDURE
