Raymond Bouchard Memorial Bursary

INTRODUCTION

This fund was created in memory of Raymond Bouchard. Raymond was a creative practitioner of innovative ideas, and a relentless scout for emergent knowledge and technological pathways associated with societal change. He provided his colleagues, clients and peers with an enhanced understanding of the origins, deployment and prospective impacts of science and technology. Raymond drew his unique insights and creative agility from his broad reading and eclectic interests.

From foundations as a mathematician, Raymond had a diverse career that included early planning and analysis work at the federal Treasury Board Secretariat and the Ministry of State for Science and Technology. He then joined IBM where he worked in areas of product development and documentation, government relations and sales management for major institutional accounts.

In his later years, Raymond founded Drachma-Denarius Inc., a consultancy specializing in the study of change and technology futures. Raymond worked on several major foresight studies undertaken by the National Research Council of Canada and over 20 federal partner organizations, and by the time of his death, he had become one of Canada's leading analysts of technology and scenario planning.

PURPOSE OF THE FUND

To provide financial assistance to students in the areas of mathematics, science or ethics.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria:

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident;
2. be enrolled full-time or part-time as an undergraduate student in an Honours BSc or a Major program in mathematics or science at the Faculty of Science, or in the Minor in Applied Ethics program at Faculty of Arts of the University of Ottawa;
3. demonstrate academic excellence (a CGPA of 7.0 and above);
4. meet the Ontario residency requirement, as per OSAP² rules; and
5. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.
