INTRODUCTION

PURPOSE OF FUND

To assist female Franco-Ontarian students enrolled in an upper year of a bachelor's program at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ottawa.

AWARD DETAILS

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a woman who is a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected or refugee status;
- Be enrolled full or part time in second, third, fourth or fifth year of a bachelor's program at the Faculty of Arts of the University of Ottawa;
- Be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP regulations;²
- Demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa;
- Be enrolled in a French-language program; and
- Be in good academic standing.

Award value: \$1,000

Number of awards: Variable

Award frequency: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate

Application deadline: October 31

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through uoZone, and should include the Financial Questionnaire.
