INTRODUCTION

The Sharon Cook Annual Award for Excellence in Teacher Education and Global Engagement is offered to any candidate in the second year of the Primary/Junior, Junior/Intermediate or Intermediate/Senior Divisions of the Anglophone Teacher Education Program in the Faculty of Education who exhibits exemplary course work and community service in support of Global and Peace Education. The Award, for \$1,000 annually, is intended to recognize superior performance by teacher candidates rather than financial need.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- 1. be registered as a full-time student in the second year of the Anglophone Teacher Education Program in the Faculty of Education of the University of Ottawa;
- 2. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee status;
- 3. demonstrate academic excellence; and
- 4. demonstrate leadership experiences.
