INTRODUCTION

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- 1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
- 2. be admitted and registered full-time or part-time to the first year of the French or English JD program;
- 3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa;
- 4. demonstrate academic excellence; and
- 5. demonstrate past or presents acts of volunteerism.

Note: Preference will be given to students with a connection to the regional municipalities of Kitchener, Waterloo or Cambridge.
