# Bar Exam Crackers Bursary

## INTRODUCTION

## PURPOSE OF FUND

To support an immigrant or a first-generation Canadian enrolled in the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section.

## SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

### Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident who has immigrated to Canada OR who is the child of a person who has immigrated to Canada;
2. be registered as a full-time or part-time student in the final year of a three-year program in the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section of the University of Ottawa; and
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.

**Value of the award:** \$1,000

**Number of awards:** One (1)

**Frequency of the award:** Annual

**Level or program of study:** Undergraduate

**Application deadline:** October 31

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through uoZone, and should include:

1. the Financial Questionnaire; and
2. proof of status as a permanent resident OR as a Canadian citizen who is an immigrant to Canada or the child of an immigrant to Canada. Documentation must include the applicant's (or applicant's parent's) country of origin.
