# Award of Excellence for Community Service

## PURPOSE OF FUND

Allocate an award to students at the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section or Civil Law Section, or students participating in the School of Government program, in recognition of their outstanding community service.

## SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

### Eligibility criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
- be enrolled as a full-time student at the University of Ottawa in a program at the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section or Civil Law Section, or in the School of Government program
- have demonstrated excellence through a variety of community service activities in diverse environments and communities
