

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AN ENDOWED FUND

NAME OF ENDOWED FUND

Alban and Raymonde Garon Memorial Bursary

INTRODUCTION

This fund was generously created in memory of the Honourable Alban Garon, an alumnus of the Faculty of Law of the University of Ottawa, and his wife Raymonde (born Lurette), who tragically passed away on June 29, 2007.

The Honourable Alban Garon was born on March 4, 1930 in St-Lambert-de-Lévis, Québec. He studied at the University of Ottawa and the Université Laval. In 1955, he was called to the Bar of Quebec , and was named a Queen's Counsel in 1968. He practised law with the Canadian Department of Justice from 1955 until 1986. Garon was a legal professor at the University of Ottawa from 1956 until 1978 and from 1986 until 1992. In September 1988, he was appointed a judge in the Tax Court of Canada , and was made associate chief judge eleven years later. In February 2000, he was named Chief Judge, and was made Chief Justice in July 2003.

PURPOSE OF FUND

Financially support undergraduate students at the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section of the University of Ottawa.

BURSARY DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
2. be registered as a full-time student in an undergraduate program at the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section of the University of Ottawa; and
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.

Value of the award: Minimum \$1,000

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate

Application deadline: October 31

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through the uoZone portal, and should include the Financial Questionnaire.

In the case of multiple candidates meeting the base requirements, the selection committee will select the recipient based on the award policies and standard criteria used by the Civil Law Section and the Financial Aid and Awards Service at the time of selection.
