INTRODUCTION

This bursary was generously created by Adrienne Smith (JD '12) in memory of Nicole LaViolette, a beloved uOttawa Faculty of Law professor, community builder, and leading scholar and expert in LGBTQ2S+ refugee and immigration issues.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To support an undergraduate student at the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section, involved in the LGBTQ2S+ community.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected or refugee status, or an international student.
- Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section, of the University of Ottawa.
- Be involved in the LGBTQ2S+ community.
- Demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.
