# NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY BURSARIES

## INTRODUCTION

In establishing this mobility fund, the Civil Law Section is choosing to invest in its students' future. The initiative opens the door to new perspectives, discovery of other legal cultures and transformative personal experiences. Offering the possibility of studying or taking part in a moot abroad or elsewhere in Canada means encouraging curiosity, confidence and engagement, essential qualities in shaping a generation of jurists open to the world and ready to make change.

## PURPOSE OF FUND

To support students enrolled in the licentiate in civil law program who have passed a summer course offered outside Canada's capital or abroad, or have taken part in a national or international interfaculty contest for which costs are not fully covered by the University of Ottawa or another institution, and who demonstrate financial need.

## AWARD DETAILS

### Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected or refugee status, or an international student.
2. Be enrolled in the second, third or fourth year of an undergraduate program in the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section, of the University of Ottawa.
3. Demonstrate financial need.
4. Enroll in a summer course given outside Canada's capital or abroad, or be taking part in a national or international interfaculty contest for which costs are not fully covered by the University of Ottawa or another institution.

**Note:** Payment of the award will only be issued in August upon successfully completion of the course or contest.
