

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AN ENDOWED FUND

NAME OF ENDOWMENT FUND (OSOTF¹)

Diana-Lynn and Louis Perret Scholarship fund

INTRODUCTION

This fund was created in 1997 by Louis Perret (Dipl. DV '70), while he was Dean at the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section, and by his wife Diana-Lynn, who has introduced many students to legal research during her career at the Law Library. The donors thank the Alumni Association and the Government of Ontario who helped create this fund through their generous matching contributions.

PURPOSE OF FUND

Provide financial assistance to students registered in the National Law program at the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section, and whose education would otherwise be compromised.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. hold a Baccalaureate of Laws in Common Law and be registered as a full-time student in the National Law Program at the Faculty of Law, Civil Law Section;
2. Be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules; and
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.
