## NAME OF ENDOWED FUND (OSOTF)

#### Wildeboer Dellelce LLP Business Law Scholarship

### INTRODUCTION

Thanks to the generosity and leadership of Perry Dellelce (LL.B. 1990) and Wildeboer Dellelce LLP, a \$100,000 contribution has been made to the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section at the University of Ottawa. While it is given in the name of Wildeboer Dellelce LLP, the portion of this gift given by Mr. Dellelce personally, being \$90,000, represents the largest personal contribution received to date (December 2006) by Common Law from one of its graduates presently engaged in the practice of law in a firm setting. - 4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa;
- 5. be in good academic standing;
- 6. demonstrate significant involvement in community service; and

7. demonstrate a strong interest in business law through participation in courses or activities such as a business clinic or other initiatives.
