

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AN ANNUAL FUND

Title of annual fund

Jacques G. Robichon MD Scholarship for students residing in Quebec

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship honours the memory of Jacques Robichon, MD, MSc, FRCS(C), and was initiated by his son Georges Robichon (B.A. 1969, LL.B. 1972). Dr. Robichon was a professor in the University of Ottawa's Department of Orthopedic Surgery and was named Vice-Dean at the Faculty of Medicine in 1966.

A similar scholarship, the Jacques G. Robichon MD Scholarship, was created by Dr. Robichon's wife Marion H. Robichon, and their children Georges Robichon (B.A. 1969, LL.B. 1972), Joanne Curran (BScN. 1974), Lina Robichon-Hunt (BSc. 1976) and Jacques Robichon (BAAdm. 1978). It is offered to Faculty of Medicine students who are Ontario residents.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to undergraduate students residing in Quebec who are registered in the Faculty of Medicine.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be registered as a full-time undergraduate student at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ottawa;
2. be a Canadian citizen;
3. be a Quebec resident;
4. demonstrate the greatest financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
5. demonstrate academic excellence.
