INTRODUCTION

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to University of Ottawa medical students who qualify under the terms established by the Ontario Trust Student Support.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicants must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee status;
2. be registered full-time at the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Ottawa;
3. meet the Ontario residency requirement, as per OSAP² rules;
4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
5. have a record of good academic achievement.
