Name of endowment fund (OSOTF¹)

Dr. Frederick O'Brien Memorial Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This fund was established in 1997 by Dr. Joseph P. O'Sullivan (Medical Class of 1982) and by the O'Brien family, in memory of Dr. Frederick O'Brien, Medical class of 1955. The donors thank the Alumni Association of the University of Ottawa and the Government of Ontario for their matching contributions.

PURPOSE OF FUND

The purpose of the fund is to provide financial assistance to University of Ottawa medical students who qualify under the terms established by the OSOTF, and whose education would otherwise be compromised.

The applicant must:

1. be registered full-time at the Faculty of Medicine at the University of Ottawa;
2. be an Ontario resident as per OSAP² rules; and
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.
