Name of endowed fund (OSOTF¹)

Dazé-Oleksiuk Scholarship in Medicine

INTRODUCTION

This fund was established in 2003 by Dr. Stanley Oleksiuk, MD '55B. The donor thanks the University of Ottawa for its contribution in making this fund possible during his living.

PURPOSE OF FUND

Provide financial assistance to an undergraduate student registered to the MD program at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ottawa whose education would otherwise be compromised.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee status;
2. be registered as a full-time undergraduate student to the MD program at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ottawa;
3. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules; and
4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To be considered for this scholarship, you must apply through the Multiple Financial Need Bursaries -M.D. Program (99931), which can be accessed through uoZone, and should include:

1. the Financial Questionnaire

In the case of multiple candidates meeting the base requirements, the selection committee will select the recipient based on the award policies and standard criteria used by the Faculty of Medicine and the Financial Aid and Awards Service at the time of selection.
