PURPOSE OF FUND

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

- 1. be an international student;
- 2. have completed their high school or university undergraduate studies at an institution in Greece;
- 3. be accepted and thereafter registered as a full-time student in an undergraduate or graduate program at the University of Ottawa; and
- 4. demonstrate academic excellence during the admission process.

Value of the award: Minimum \$10,000

Number of awards: Variable Frequency of the award: Annual

Renewable: One year (must maintain good academic standing and full-time status)

Level or program of study: Undergraduate and graduate **Application contact:** Financial Aid and Awards Service

Application deadline: March 31
