Kildonan Education Award

INTRODUCTION

The fund was established in 2000 by an anonymous donor from the Kildonan Education Fund which is administered by the Community Foundation of Ottawa.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to a deserving student registered at the University of Ottawa.

AWARD DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. have graduated from a high school in the region of Ottawa;
2. be registered as a full-time student from September to April at the University of Ottawa;
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
4. demonstrate academic excellence.

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate and graduate

APPLICATION PROCEDURE
