SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen;
2. provide proof of eligibility in accordance with the University of Ottawa's policy on *Eligibility for Focused Admissions, Scholarships and Bursaries for First Nations, Inuit and Métis People*, and Indspire's *Building Brighter Futures: Bursaries, Scholarships, and Awards* program policy;
3. be registered full-time or part-time in an undergraduate or graduate program at the University of Ottawa; and
4. be in good academic standing.
