INTRODUCTION

This scholarship fund has been generously supported by Cenovus Energy to provide support to Indigenous students and create new experiential learning opportunities for them, in partnership with Positive Energy, Indspire and the First Nations Major Projects Coalition.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To support undergraduate and graduate students at the University of Ottawa who demonstrate academic excellence. The scholarship will be administered by Indspire, in partnership with the Positive Energy Chair in Energy Policy and Regulation.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen;
2. be enrolled full-time or part time in an undergraduate or graduate program at the University of Ottawa;
3. demonstrate academic excellence; and
4. provide documented proof of Indigenous identity, in accordance with the requirements of the University of Ottawa Eligibility for Focused Admissions, Scholarships, and Bursaries for First Nations, Inuit, and Métis People administrative procedure.
