NAME OF NON ENDOWED FUND

Manon Lacasse Scholarship for Women's Hockey (Sports)

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was established by Manon Lacasse to assist the uOttawa Gee-Gees women's hockey program and to recognize the hard work and commitment of student-athletes. Manon, a Franco-Ontarian, has been involved in the hockey community for many years as a referee and player and has been a strong supporter of the Gee-Gees women's hockey team. She created the scholarship to encourage excellence, leadership and community involvement among members of the Gee-Gees women's hockey team and to recognize a member of the program who demonstrates these qualities while successfully balancing their studies and hockey commitments.

PURPOSE OF FUND

Award a scholarship to a varsity student-athlete who is a member of the Gee-Gees women's hockey team at the University of Ottawa.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
2. be registered as a full-time undergraduate student at the University of Ottawa;
3. be a varsity student-athlete, as per OUA, RSEQ and USports regulations;
4. be a member of the Gee-Gees women's hockey team;
5. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
6. demonstrate outstanding potential in their sport.

Value of the award: Minimum \$1,000

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate
