Introduction

This fund was initiated through the initiative of Mr. John R. Morrissey (LL.B.'74) who graduated with Mr. Rémi Michael Beaupré (LL.B.'74, LL.L.'75, LL.M.'79) from the Faculty of Law, Common Law Section in 1974. With the approval from the family, Mr. Morrissey wrote to Michael's classmates of 1974 for donations towards the establishment of a fund in his memory. Michael Beaupré passed away in 1989. Mr. Beaupré's immediate family is the major contributor to this fund.

Purpose of fund

Financially support students who are registered in the JD program or in the LL.L. program at the Faculty of Law

Scholarship details

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
2. be registered as a full-time student in the JD program at the Common Law Section or the LL.L. program at the Civil Law Section of the Faculty of Law of the University of Ottawa; and
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.

Value of the award:	Minimum \$500
Number of awards:	Two (one to a JD student, and one to a LL.L. student)
Frequency of the award:	Annual
Level or program of study:	Undergraduate
