NAME OF NON-ENDOWED FUND

Eric Danis Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This award was created to honour the memory of Eric Danis and the impact he had on the CHEO Foundation, the University of Ottawa and the Ottawa community. Eric's kind and selfless nature and his emphasis on giving to others is the legacy on which CASCO (the Commerce and Administration Student Charity Organization) was built. This award will recognize a student driven to exceed expectations and enhance the CHEO Foundation, the University and the city by exemplifying the traits that Eric embodied.

PURPOSE OF FUND

Provide financial assistance to a student who has completed at least one year as a CASCO member.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with the protected/refugee status or an international student;
2. be registered in an undergraduate or graduate program at the University of Ottawa;
3. be a current or past member of CASCO (for a minimum of one year with the organization); and
4. have distinguished themselves through their involvement with CASCO.

Value of the award: \$1,000

Number of awards: One

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate and graduate

Application deadline: November 3

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through the uoZone portal, and should include:

1. the Curriculum Vitae on Online Scholarships and Bursaries;
2. a proof of CASCO membership; and
3. an essay from the applicant (250 words) addressed to the President of CASCO, and explaining their involvement with CASCO and why they merit this award.

In the case of multiple candidates meeting the base requirements, the selection committee will select the recipient based on the award policies and standard criteria used by the Financial Aid and Awards Service at the time of selection.
