NAME OF ENDOWED FUND (OSOTF¹)

Dorothy Thompson Awards

INTRODUCTION

This fund was established by John Thompson on behalf of the Thompson Family to assist the football program and to honour their mother, Dorothy Thompson, whose three sons played CIAU football at three different schools. John and Vince both played at the University of Ottawa (1960-1966) where they were captains, conference all-star selections and most deserving player awardees. Chris played at Carleton University (1976-1979) where he was captain and a conference all-star. Chris coached at Ottawa with Jim Daley and Larry Ring. John also played at the University of Western Ontario while at graduate business school.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to students who play interuniversity football or women's interuniversity sports, and whose education would otherwise be compromised.

AWARD DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee status;
2. be registered as a full-time student-athlete (as per OUA, USports and RSEQ regulations) at the University of Ottawa;
3. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules;
4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
5. be a member of the USports interuniversity football program or a women's USports interuniversity program, with preference given to women's swimming, women's cross-country and women's rugby
