NAME OF ENDOWMENT FUND (OSOTF¹)

Ottawa Valley Quilters' Guild Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This fund was established by the Ottawa Valley Quilters' Guild. The aims and objectives of the guild are to provide fellowship, to establish and maintain quilting standards, to sponsor workshops, speakers, quilt shows, group excursions, demonstrations, to work on community projects and to publish a newsletter. Membership is open to all persons interested in quilting. The founders of this fund appreciate the matching contribution of the Government of Ontario through its Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund program.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide funds to students doing research in the design of, creation, use, history, production, manufacture, marketing, sales, conservation, and hazards of textile related subjects.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be registered as a full-time or part-time student at the University of Ottawa;
2. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules;
3. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
4. do research in the design of, creation, use, history, production, manufacture, marketing, sales, conservation, and hazards of textile related subjects.
