NAME OF ENDOWED FUND (OSOTF^[1])

Joël Gagnon Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

The fund was established by the Gee-Gees Hockey Committee in memory of one of the Gee-Gees goal tenders, Joël Gagnon who lost his life in an automobile accident in July 1997. Drafted by the Anaheim Mighty Ducks in 1993, Joël became the fifth ranked goalie in the OUA. Despite his hockey history, most will remember Joël for who he was. His fiery personality and intense leadership made him a good leader and most importantly a great friend. His team-mates and friends will never forget his good humour and always smiling face.

The founders of this fund appreciate the matching contribution of the Government of Ontario through its Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund program and to donors who contributed to this fund.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to student-athletes who are members of the University of Ottawa men's hockey team whose education would otherwise be compromised.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee status;
2. be registered as a full-time student-athlete (as determined by OUA and USports), and a member of the University of Ottawa men's hockey team;
3. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP^[2] rules; and
4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.

Value of the award: Minimum \$1,000

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate or graduate

Application deadline: June 1
