NAME OF ENDOWED FUND (OSOTF¹)

Geneviève De Celles Fund

INTRODUCTION

This fund was created by Raymond L. De Celles in memory of his mother Geneviève. The De Celles have a long family history at the University of Ottawa. Geneviève De Celles graduated from Collège Bruyère, an affiliate of the University of Ottawa. Mr. De Celles, a graduate of the University and former member of the Ottawa Gee-Gees hockey team, was sitting on the University's Board of Governors when the fund was created. Raymond's wife, Hélène Dazé-De Celles is also a University of Ottawa graduate and was president of the Alumni Association from 1992 to 1994. Their three children, Dominique (B.Ad. 82, B.Com. 83), Luc (B.Soc.Sc. 87) and Marc (B.Ad. 85), are also University of Ottawa alumni. The founder of this fund thanks the donors who have contributed to this fund, and the Alumni Association of the University of Ottawa and the Government of Ontario for their matching contribution.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to student athletes who are members of the Ottawa Gee-Gees hockey team and whose education would otherwise be compromised.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee status;
2. be registered as a full-time student athlete (as determined by the OUA and USports), and a member of the Gee- Gees hockey team at the University of Ottawa;
3. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules; and
4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.

Value of the award: Variable, up to the maximum stipulated in OUA and USports rules and regulations

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate or graduate

Application deadline: June 1
