NAME OF ENDOWED FUND (OSOTF¹)

GUARISCO FAMILY FUND

INTRODUCTION

This fund was established by Ken Guarisco (BA '77). Mr. Guarisco was a member of the University of Ottawa football team from 1973 to 1977 and served as a coach for the team in 1978 and 1979. In 1997, when this fund was created, he was president of the 13th Man Football Alumni Association. The donor thanks the Alumni Association of the University of Ottawa and the Government of Ontario for their matching contributions.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to students who are part of the women's rugby team.

BURSARY DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with protected or refugee status;
2. be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at the Telfer School of Management;
3. be enrolled as a student-athlete, according to OUA, RSEQ and U Sports criteria;
4. be a member of the Gee-Gees women's rugby team;
5. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules; and
6. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa.
