

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AN ENDOWED FUND

NAME OF ENDOWED FUND (OSOTF¹)

Sports Services Track and Field Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was established by Sports Services thanks to contributions received throughout the 1999-2000 academic year from its many sponsors and partners, who wanted to recognize the positive impact athletics have on student life.

The founders of this fund appreciate the matching contribution of the Government of Ontario through its Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund program.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to student athletes, members of the University of Ottawa Gee-Gees track and field program whose education would otherwise be compromised.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee;
2. be registered as a full-time student athlete (as determined by the OUA and USports) of the University of Ottawa;
3. be a member of the Gee-Gees track and field program at the University of Ottawa;
4. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP² rules;
5. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
6. be a student in good standing and have a minimum average of 70 % (or an AGPA of 6) in accordance with OUA and Usports eligibility criteria.

Value of the award: Minimum \$500, up to the maximum stipulated in the OUA and Usports regulations

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate and graduate

Application deadline: June 1

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To be considered for this scholarship, candidates must apply to the *Varsity Student-Athletes Scholarship* (99935). Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through <https://scholarships.uottawa.ca>, and should include the Financial Questionnaire.
