

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR AN ENDOWED FUND

NAME OF ENDOWED FUND (OSOTF^[1])

Sports Services Badminton Scholarship

INTRODUCTION

This scholarship was established by Sports Services thanks to contributions received throughout the 1999-2000 academic year from its many sponsors and partners, who wanted to recognize the positive impact the students have on student life. The founders of this fund appreciate the matching contribution of the Government of Ontario through its Ontario Student Opportunity Trust Fund program.

PURPOSE OF FUND

To provide financial assistance to student athletes who are members of the University of Ottawa Gee-Gees badminton team, and whose education would otherwise be compromised.

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant must:

1. be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or a person with the protected/refugee status;
2. be registered as a full-time student athlete (as determined by the OUA and USports) at the University of Ottawa, and a member of the Gee-Gees badminton team;
3. be an Ontario resident, as per OSAP rules^[2] ;
4. demonstrate financial need, as determined by the Financial Aid and Awards Service of the University of Ottawa; and
5. be in good academic standing and have a minimum average of 70 %, in accordance with OUA/USports eligibility criteria.

Value of the award: Variable, up to the maximum stipulated in the OUA and USports rules and regulations

Number of awards: Variable

Frequency of the award: Annual

Level or program of study: Undergraduate or graduate

Application deadline: June 1

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through uoZone, and should include the Financial Questionnaire.
