Scholarship details

Eligibility criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected or refugee status, or an international student.
2. Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student in the Faculty of Science of the University of Ottawa.
3. Be enrolled for the upcoming Fall term.
4. Demonstrate community involvement and/or school spirit and involvement at the University of Ottawa.
5. Be in good academic standing.

Application procedure

Applications must be made through Online Scholarships and Bursaries, which can be accessed through uoZone. They should include the following:

1. the CV on Online Scholarships and Bursaries
2. a non-official copy of the applicant's transcript
3. a letter from the applicant (max. 500 words) detailing their community involvement and/or active spirit and involvement in the University of Ottawa, as well as explaining why they embody the spirit of the award
